The conference aims to bring together people with an interest in cancer and exercise to share research and best clinical practice. Abstracts/ posters should be relevant to the field of exercise with people with cancer.

We aim to display the winning posters virtually during the conference breaks and will share all posters for viewing as part of the electronic resources made available to all participants as part of the conference.

Abstracts (up to 250 words) can be sent to Catherine.Sandsund@rmh.mhs.uk by 23 July 2021 for consideration. We will aim to notify you in early August.

- Abstracts must be relevant to field of physical activity or exercise with people with cancer and can be reviews, case reports, audit, quality improvement, service evaluation or research projects
- The work can have been published or taken to other conferences
- Abstracts will be selected by peer-review for inclusion in the conference. For people less familiar with academic writing, do approach local supports such as the [Council for Allied Health Professions Research | Council for Allied Health Professions Research \(csp.org.uk\)](http://csp.org.uk), or [Academic Health Sciences Network](http://academichealthsciencesnetwork.org) for coaching and support. - Accepted abstracts should then be presented as a poster for the conference

Poster presentation guidelines

- All expenses associated with submission of the poster, conference registration fees, are the responsibility of the presenter
- Please submit the poster in the landscape (16:9) PowerPoint version and also with a PDF for best viewing on the virtual platform. Please clearly label your poster with title, author/s and contact details
- All posters must be non-commercial in nature and not be used as a marketing opportunity. Non-compliance with this rule will result in the poster being rejected
- **The deadline for poster submissions is 7 Sept 2021** however early submission is advised. All submissions should include your name, email address and contact telephone number and be sent to electronically to catherine.sandsund@rmh.nhs.uk
- All submitted posters will be made available electronically as a .pdf document for conference participants.
